- Geographical location

Dublin is the capital of Ireland. It is situated at East of the country and it overlooks on the Ireland sea.

It was founded by the Vikings like a center for the commerc of the slaves, the city is situated on the estuary of the Liffey river, at the center of the oriental coast of the Island and now it is called Dublin Region, it overlooks of the Ireland sea. It was the Ireland capital since medieval times.

It is the largest city and most populated city of the Island.

The inhabitants of the metropolitan area exceeds one million.



- Monuments:
 - The Cathedral of Christ is one of the main monuments of the Ireland capital.



A'ras an Uachtaráin is the presidential Ireland residence, it is situated in Phoenix Park, in the Northside of Dublin.



Four Courts is an elegant palace of Dublin, on the North side of the Liffey, which houses the supreme courts of justice in Ireland.



Leinster House is from the 1922 the seat of parliament of the Irish Free State and of the Republic of Ireland.



- Temple Bar is a neighborhood in the center of Dublin. The neighborhood is the nightlife center and it is home to many pubs and clubs.



- The Spire is a steel tower situated in O'Connell Street in Dublin, it's tall 120 meters.



- Fusiliers Arch is a monument situated in the center of Dublin to commemorate the hundreds of thousands of victims who died in the Boer War.

- Phoenix park located near the center of the city, it is considered by many people the largest municipal park in Europe.
- Dublin's got GUINNESS a beer factory famous all over the world.
- Dublin's got a lot of pub. The oldest is called Brazen Head it's located along the Liffey and it's dates back to 1198.

- The Point is one of the covered arenas for big concert, with a capacity of 8500 seats. After the end of the renovation work it can hold 14000 people.
