- London is the capital of England.

Where is it?



Big Ben

- It is located next to the house of parliament.
- 'Big Ben' is the nickname of the bell.
- It is illuminated by 133 bulbs.
- Since 2012 it has been called the 'Elizabeth Tower



Tower Bridge

- It is a bascule bridge located on the River Thames.
- The name means 'Il Ponte della Torre'
- It connects the Southwark district to the tower of London.
- This bridge is closed when the ships pass through.





London Eye

- The name means 'L'occhio di Londra'.
- It is the tallest Ferris wheel in Europe.
- It has become the main attraction of the United Kingdom with 3.5 million visitors a year.
- Its construction began in 1998 and ended on May 9, 2000.



Hyde park

- It is one of the nine Royal Parks of London.
- It is divided into 2 parts by the artificial lake
 'serpentine lake'



Bukingham palace

- It is located in central London, and is the residence of the royal family.
- It's where numerous public ceremonies take place.
- It is also famous for the 'changing of the guard.'



Westmister Abbey

- It is the seat of the coronations of kings and burial of important people.
- An important tomb is that of Isaac Newton.



House of parlament

- It is the building in which they are located the two houses of parliament of the United Kingdom: the House of Commons (which is elected by the people) and the House of Lords (the title of Lord is handed down from father to son).
- It is located on the north bank of the Thames.
- The oldest part dates back to 1097.



Taxis and double decker buses

- Taxis are famous around the world for being advertised by cine but and television.
- The double-decker bus is a special type of bus on two levels.





Underground

- It is the oldest underground network in the world, the largest in Europe and second in the world.
- The ducts of sewers were used and cleaned for the first travel segment.
