The Eastern Blue Bird is a medium sized song bird (small thrush), with a shirt tile chunky body, large round head short black bill, a reddish-orange chest, and blue wings and tile.

Thier diet consists of insects and small fruits.

BROOK TROUT

Brook Trout lives under water on conditions that are cool, clean and pure.

Brook Trout prefers aquatic insects but will eat whatever they can find including land insects that fall into the water, small crayfish, and other small fish and minnows when they are easy to catch.



State nickname

THE EMPIRE STATE

New York is nicknamed "The Empire State" for its national and global significance. The origin of the nickname is unknown - some sources credit George Washington, who referred to New York state in December 1784 as at present the seat of the Empire



State insect

NINE-SPOTTED **LADYBUG**

The nine-spotted ladybug is a native species that ranged across the U.S. and Southern Canada.

Although the nine-spotted ladybug beetle continues to persist, it has become very rare.

Ladybugs help gardeners and farmers by eating tiny insect pests that damage plants.



State capital

ALBANY

Albany is the capital of New York state for its location on the Hudson River.

When it became capital in 1797 its population was nearly 5,000 people.

Albany is one of the oldest surviving European settlements from the original thirteen colonies and the longest continuously chartered city in the United States.

MANHATTAN

Manhattan is one of the five boroughs of New York City, in the state of New York in the United States.

It hosts three of the world's 10 most-visited tourist attractions in 2013: Times Square, Central Park, and Grand Central Terminal.

Manhattan is often said to be the economic and cultural center of the United States and hosts the United Nations Headquarters and Wall Street.



NEW YORK CITY

It is the most populous city in the United States and the center of the New York metropolitan area, the premier gateway for legal immigration to the United States and one of the most populous urban agglomerations in the world.

Situated on one of the world's largest natural harbors, New York City consists of five boroughs, each of which is a separate county of New York State. It is the most densely populated major city in the United States. As many as 800 languages are spoken in New York making it the most linguistically diverse city in the world.
