STATE ANIMAL



The state animal is the Desert bighorn sheep

After eight years of growth, the horns of an adult ram may weigh more than 30 pounds. Annual growth rings indicate the animal's age.

STATE FLOWER



The state flower is the Sagebrush.

Sagebrushes are native to the North American west. It produces small, yellow and white flowers in the late summer or early fall. Native American Indians used the leaves of Sagebrush for medicines.

STATE FLAG



The state flag is called “ The flag of Nevada”

Above the star is a golden-yellow scroll with the words “Battle Born”, one of the state’s motts (infact Nevada becoming a state during the American Civil War). Below the star and the state name are two sprays of green sagebrush with yellow flowers

STATE BIRD



The state bird is the Mountain bluebird.

It is an omnivore and it can live 6 to 10 years in the wild. It eats spiders, grasshoppers, flies and other insects, and small fruits.

STATE FISH



The state fish is Lahontan Cutthroat Trout

The Lahontan Cutthroat Trout's habitat ranges from high mountain creeks and alpine lakes to warm lowland streams.

STATE NICKNAME



The state nickname is The Silver State.

During Nevada silver rush days of the mid 1800's, silver was literally shoveled off the ground in Nevada; heavy gray crusts of silver had formed on the surface of the desert over millions of years.

STATE INSECT



The state insect is Vivid Dancer Damselfly

Nevada designated the Vivid Dancer Damselfly as the official state insect in
2009

STATE CAPITAL

Carson City is an independent city and the capital of the US state of Nevada, named after the mountain man Kit Carson. It was chosen following the discovery of gold and silver near the city and Carson City's population began to rise.

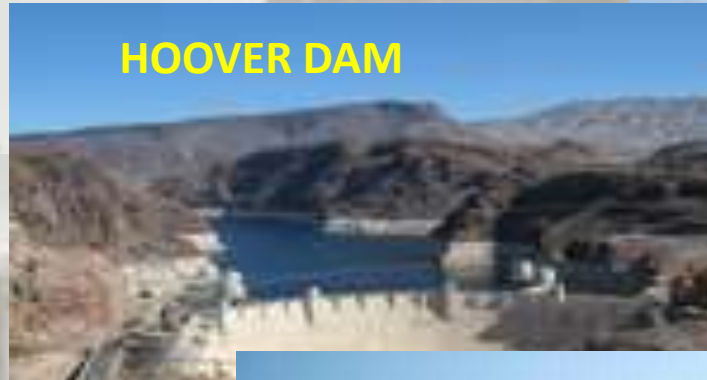
